



2020 Play in the Park Camp Active Arts & Creative Play

Dear Parents/Guardians,

It has been Hutch Rec's goal to provide a safe and fun place for youth in our community to attend when school is not in session in the summer. We accomplished one of these goals in the past with our Stay to Play summer day camp. Unfortunately, we had to cancel this year's Stay to Play due to COVID-19 precautions. However, this provided the opportunity to try a new style of camp that continues to provide that safe and fun place for the youth in our community.

Play in the Park participants will enjoy a week-long adventure of PLAY – from theatre, sports, recreation, enrichment, arts and crafts, to several other opportunities through a shared community experience. Activities and presentations will be facilitated by Hutch Rec and local professionals.

Camp is open to youth ages 5 to 12 years old. Sessions are held Monday through Friday, 9 a.m. to noon, and start/end the day at the Homebuilder's Shelter Building in Carey Park. Weekly sessions include:

- Session 1: June 29-July 3
- Session 2: July 6-10
- Session 3: July 13-17
- Session 4: July 20-24
- Session 5: July 27-31

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Children may NOT participate Play in the Park camp program if:

- Diagnosed with COVID-19
- Under orders to quarantine related to COVID-19
- Showing symptoms related to COVID-19, which include: Fever of 100.4 or greater; Sore throat; Cough (along with other symptoms); Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing; New loss of taste or smell; Vomiting or diarrhea; Chills; and/or Living or in close contact with a person with symptomatic lab-confirmed COVID-19 or showing any symptoms related to COVID-19.

Additional COVID-19 Precautions:

Your child’s health and safety are a top priority. We will follow the proper guidelines set for by the Kansas Recreation & Parks Association (KRPA) and local health authorities, including:

- At drop-off each morning, camp staff will ask the parent/guardian if the child is experiencing COVID-19 symptoms (listed above).
- If a camper develops a fever of 100 degrees or higher or is experiencing a consistent cough during the camp period, a parent will be notified immediately to be picked up. The camper may return to camp after being symptom-free for 72 hours.
- Parents are responsible to let the Camp Director know immediately if his/her child has COVID-19 symptoms or has been exposed.

KEY REMINDERS:

Camper Arrival (8:45-9:00 a.m.) and Pick-up (11:45 a.m.-12:00 p.m.):

- Arrival and Pick-Up will be done in the Homebuilder’s Shelter Building in Carey Park.
- Parents must fill out the Authorization for Pick-Up form prior to the first day of camp. Only those listed on the form will be allowed to pick up the child.

What Campers Should Wear & Bring:

- Protective footwear (sneakers, hiking shoes, boots, etc.) – a must! No sandals, flip-flops, or open-toed shoes.
- Personal hand sanitizer is encouraged (travel size or smaller bottle sizes recommended)
- (optional) Snack in a throwaway baggie/package.
- Water bottles (to be refilled throughout the day) labeled with the child’s name.
- Hats, bug spray, sunscreen for personal use – to be applied only by parents or camper (to self). We ask that parents apply sunscreen and bug spray prior to attending camp.
- Backpack or cinch sack to keep all personal items together. PLEASE PUT YOUR CHILD’S NAME ON EVERYTHING HE/SHE BRINGS BEFORE COMING TO CAMP!
- Leave all technology devices at home. If a camper MUST have a mobile phone, we ask that it be kept in the Homebuilder’s Shelter Building during camp hours. Hutch Rec is not responsible for any items lost, stolen, or damaged.
