



2020-21 YOUTH BASKETBALL: COVID-19 GUIDELINES

CONTACT TRACING SPECIAL STATEMENT: Depending on the level of community spread, local and state public health departments may need to implement mitigation strategies for public health functions to identify cases and conduct contact tracing. We will be using information provided at registration that includes parent/guardian contact information, including phone number, mailing address, and email address. If a possible COVID-19 case is reported from any participant or spectator, Hutch Rec will notify the local health department to provide details and seek direction.

Additional benches, chairs, or other equipment may be added to where substitutes sit to allow spacing and social distancing.	Signage will be displayed encouraging hand washing/healthy practices, social distancing, and describing what rule adjustments have been made. Staff will be empowered to enforce.	Two adult spectators will be allowed per participant; no siblings or children not involved in the program. Bleachers are not available and spectators must bring their own chairs. Spectators must sit within their family units.
